Immunization Clinic



Information

Immunization clinics are held monthly at the Orland Township office, where free vaccines are administered to Orland Township residents 18 and under; eligibility restrictions apply.*

A parent or legal guardian must accompany a child unless special arrangements are made with the Health Services department prior to the clinic.

*Requirements:

- Every child must bring an up-to-date U.S. immunization record.
- All Medicaid cards will be checked through Medi system. **Only** Title XIX (19) Medicaid eligible for VFC.
- A parent/legal guardian photo ID, passport and proof of residency is required.

**Clinic dates are walk-in.
No appointment necessary!

*Eligibility For VFC Vaccines

- * Live in Orland Township
- * Medicaid Title XIX (19)
- * Native American or Alaska Native
- * No Insurance
- * Underinsured (insurance does not cover vaccines, policy must be shown)

***Please note—anyone who meets the above requirements but lives outside of Orland Township boundaries will be charged a \$20 administration fee per vaccine.**
